Organization and Process

- The course days Wednesday to Saturday are intended not only for the course time but also for playing the organs of the Hofkirche.
- On Saturdays and Sundays, taking into account local events, the participants play self-designed Eucharistic celebrations, liturgical celebrations and on August 8, 2020, 19:30 h, a concert with Video-Live-Recordings.
- For organizational reasons the number of participants is limited to five (5).
